Upcoming construction and closing of State Route 60

Due to a partially collapsed culvert under Rt. 60 between Bettcher and the turnpike, the road will be closed and repaired. This culvert allows the creek to pass under Rt. 60.

This project will be managed by the Ohio Department of Transportation.

The creek runs along the turnpike and the north side of the Bettcher lower parking lot, to the lower Bettcher pond in the woods, and crosses Rt 60 through the damaged culvert.

Rt. 60 will be closed for 60/90 days, scheduled to begin about September 1st.

The surveying crews have been working there for the past 2 weeks, and bids from the contractors have been submitted to ODOT.

The roadway will be removed, the embankment will be excavated to a depth of about 28 feet, and approximately 6,000 cubic yards of soil will be removed. The culvert will be replaced, the topsoil replaced, and the roadway reconstructed.

ODOT has assured me that all of the excavation will occur on the ODOT right-of-way, and trees, topography and our northern pond will not be impacted.

They are required to maintain a free flowing condition for the creek, so rain water runoff and the outfall of our WWTP should not be adversely affected.

All employees, delivery trucks, etc. will have to re-route from Rt. 113 during this period.
